TOURNAMENT RULES

TEAMS: All Teams must be Paid in Full and a Waiver Signed by Each Player before playing. Refer to your team captain for the registration link. The waiver is sent to your email when you are added.

Rosters must be finalized before Game 1. This includes any Players and Subs. No Injury or Ejection Substitutions are allowed.

*-Goalie substitutions are allowed if an Injury occurs. Goalie must be at equal or lower talent level of the Division.

Locker Room assignments will be provided by The Ice Centre and Printed Schedules are available in the Pro-Shop. Online schedule can be found at <https://stats.pointstreak.com/players/players-leagues.html?leagueid=1060&seasonid=21318>

No Ringer / No Sandbagging Rule. Any player recognized by director as 'Too good' for the division they are in will not be allowed to play with their current team. No subs or refunds issued for sandbagging.

MAJORS AND TOURNAMENT EJECTIONS: Any player that is assessed a major penalty (fighting, intent to injure, game misconducts) will be ejected from the tournament their team will be fined \$100.00. The team incurring the penalty will NOT be allowed to play their next game until the fine is paid. The fine will be a charitable donation to Dawg Nation. Referees and Tournament Director will consult on any and all major infractions and their subsequent ruling will be final.

Any verbal or physical abuse of a Referee, Scorekeeper, or Tournament/Rink Staff Member, on or off the ice, will result in Expulsion.

Any player appearing intoxicated or exhibiting inappropriate behavior may be ejected from a Game at the Referee's discretion. Intoxicated players may also be ejected from a Game immediately by the Scorekeepers or Tournament Director at any time. Anyone under the age of 21 caught or seen drinking alcohol on the premises will be expelled from the Ice Centre.

GAME FORMAT, RULES AND STANDINGS

Round Robin and Consolation Game Format:

- All games will be 2 – 15 minute run time periods and 1 – 12 minute stop period
- Warm-up will be 3 minutes
- A 4 goal differential in the 3rd period will result in run-clock.
- No-Time outs will be permitted due to ice time constraints.
 - If necessary, off-ice crew may invoke a curfew (running clock) to keep the rinks on time

Games tied at the end of Regulation will result in a Tie.

Standings(Beer Voucher Coupons):

- Win = 2 points (2-pitchers)
- Tie = 1 point (1-pitcher)
- Loss = 0 points (1-pitcher)

Semi-Final and Final Games will be the same format with the exception of a tie.

- One Overtime period, 3-minute stop time period of 3 v 3 will be played.
- If tied after the OT, a 3-person shoot-out will begin immediately, Away team shoots first.

Tie-Breaking Procedures

1. Standings Points
2. Wins
3. Head-to-Head Record
4. Goal Differential
5. Goals Allowed
6. Lowest Penalty Minutes
7. Rock-Paper-Scissors-Lizard-Spock

Other Notable rules:

- Icing will be center red line
- Tag-up offsides
- Referees should employ quick Face-offs, within 3-5 seconds of the whistle. Be smart & ready with Line Changes.

PROTESTS & DISPUTE PROCEDURES If there are any issues or protests, please contact the Tournament Director immediately. Protests require a \$100 deposit. If it is overturned your deposit will be returned, if the call is upheld the deposit becomes a Dawg Nation charitable donation. The director has the final say in all decisions regarding the tournament.
